



## PET OWNER INFORMATION SHEET

### Eligibility for Assistance

1. Do you live on Vancouver Island?
2. Do you meet the income requirements outlined below?

Please choose ONE category, below, and provide a copy of the specified document to your vet. If your Social Insurance Number (SIN) is visible on the document, please black it out before submitting it to BFF.

	CATEGORY	PROOF OF INCOME ELIGIBILITY
1.	Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Eligibility letter (receive in June each year) <u>OR</u></li><li>• T4AOAS slip (with SIN blacked out) <u>OR</u></li><li>• GIS confirmation from Service Canada account.</li></ul>
2.	Persons with Disabilities (PWD) Designation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• "Release of Personal Information" form from your financial assistance worker <u>OR</u></li><li>• Go online to your "My Self Serve" account and print a "Confirmation of Assistance"</li></ul>
3.	Income Assistance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ministry cheque stub <u>OR</u></li><li>• Similar to #2: "Release of Personal Information" form <u>OR</u> "Confirmation of Assistance" statement</li></ul>
4.	Low income	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Notice of Assessment (or T4 with SIN blacked out) for each adult in the household, showing total household income of:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ less than \$35,000 for single-person households or</li><li>○ less than \$45,000 for households with two or more people</li></ul></li></ul>
5.	Other: Letter from a Registered Social Worker (RSW)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The letter must include: the number of people in the household, RSW name, registration number, contact info, and a statement that the pet owner is in financial need.</li></ul>
6.	Other: Letter from a Domestic Violence Shelter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The letter must include: the shelter's name, contact info, and a statement that the pet owner is in financial need.</li></ul>

BFF is committed to safeguarding all personal information in accordance with British Columbia's Personal Information Protection Act and our BFF Privacy Policy.

3. Has your vet confirmed that the treatment your pet needs is eligible for funding?

### If you answered yes to the three questions above, please provide the following to your vet:

1. **Your proof of income eligibility.** By asking your vet to submit an application, you are confirming that:
  - You are currently experiencing financial hardship and are unable to pay for the veterinary care your pet needs.
  - The information you have provided for the application and in any attachments is complete and accurate.
2. **A photo of your pet.** This is optional but by providing a photo, you agree that if your application is approved, BFF may use the name and photo of your pet and mention the treatment he or she received on BFF's social media, website, and/or publicity materials. This type of publicity is important in helping BFF to raise funds. (We will never use the pet owner's name or other personal information publicly without consent.)
